

## V.S.M.A. Spring Run , 26th. to 29th. April 2019 Additional Supplementary Regulations.

- 1. The meeting will be governed by O.O.R. Regulations, these ASRs and any written instructions the promoters may issue for the event.
- 2. The event is open to all past competitors/officials/mechanics who were involved in Scottish Motor Sport, regardless of the type or status of the Motor Sport Event, prior to 1994.
- 3. The event will be held from Friday 26th to Monday 29th April 2019 at The Newby Bridge Hotel, Cumbria. All entrants are expected to be at the Venue by 1800 hrs on Friday 26th. April to sign on. At signing-on, name badges will be provided and these should be worn throughout the event for identification purposes.
- 4. **Classes** : There will be four classes determined by the year when the Entrant started in Motor Sport.

Class 1 : Pre- 1964 Class 2 : Between 1964 and 1973 Class 3 : Between 1973 and 1984 Class 4 : Between 1984 and 1994

- 5. Entries The maximum entry for the event is 50 persons : this is determined by the accommodation available. The minimum number for the event is 30 and the minimum number per class is 5. Should the minimum numbers not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event or amalgamate classes as required.
- 6. The entry list opens on receipt of these regulations and closes on 30th March 2019 or when the maximum number is reached, whichever is earlier. All entries will be acknowledged and notice of acceptance will be posted after 30th March 2019 along with final instructions.

The **Entry Fee** will be £65.00 per person. The entry fee includes the Friday evening reception, wine with dinner on each evening, entry to Lakeland Motor Museum and the sail on Lake Windermere and entry io Stott Park Bobbin Mill,. The **Hotel Deposit** is £50.00 per person and is non-refundable We will also visit either the Crystal Glass Factory, Ulverston or the Docks Museum, Barrow-in-Furness There is no entry charge to these venues. Any entry charge for the visit to M-sport will be borne by V.S.M.A.
